FRENCH GRADING SYSTEM

As is the case in all European Union countries, French Universities use the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). ECTS credits are awarded for successfully completed studies: one academic year corresponds to 60 ECTS-credits, one semester to 30 ECTS-credits.

ECTS credits take into account the amount of work typically necessary to complete a course. Part of this work may be outside of the classroom; courses with the same number of contact hours may, therefore, have different ECTS values. UGA transcripts provide both the ECTS credits and the total contact hours for each course.

French universities use a 20-point grading scale; 20 is the highest grade and 0 is the lowest. A score of 20 is considered perfect, and is rarely if ever awarded in courses that are graded subjectively.

The "passing" grade at the UGA is 10. UGA credit is not awarded for courses with a grade below 10/20. Credit values for courses with a grade below 10, or courses where the student is marked *défaillant*, are theoretical values, and do not reflect credit actually awarded by the UGA.

The grading in French Universities is quite strict. Most passing grades fall between 10 and 14.
